REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR FREMONT No. 25 SCHOOLS

Fremont County School District No. 25 uses an online student registration/data validation system called InfoSnap, that will allow the district to collect and verify all student demographic, emergency and medical information in a condensed format for your child prior to the start of the new school year.

If your child completed the 2018-2019 school year with us, you should have already received a letter and/or email from Fremont County School District No. 25 with instructions on how to access the system for your student. The letter will contain a link with instructions and a secure "snapcode" that links directly to your student's information. If we have your correct email on file, you will also receive an email. If you receive both an email and a letter you can use either to complete your child's registration but you do not need to do both. You will create an account that you will use each year for this process, and submit a form for each student in your family. To make the process easier for families with multiple students, you will have the option to copy all generic family information to all other students in your family. If you used Infosnap last year to register your student(s), your account is already active and you do not need to create a new one. If you have a parent account through PowerSchool, you can also access the registration link for your child(ren) through that portal.

We would appreciate all families completing the online process as soon as possible after receiving the letter/email. This allows us to plan more accurately for staffing and classroom needs so we are as prepared as possible in the fall. ***Your student's registration will not be complete until the online forms have been submitted and all of the required documents are on file at the school.*** If you do not have access to the Internet, or need help using the system, please contact your child's school. If you

have not received a letter or email with your child's snapcode, please contact your student's school office.
